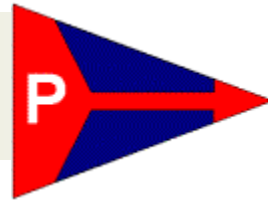

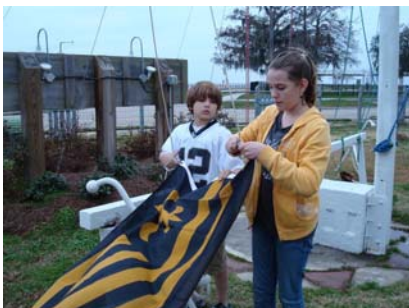
HOUSE & GROUNDS—BRIAN BURKE

The club is off to a monster start in GYA Capdevielle racing series this year. The team of Max Albert, Dave Bolyard, Avery Solberger and Brock Schmidt combined to win the second Capdevielle regatta of 2010. The win gives the sailors of Pontchartrain wins in the only Capdevielles of 2010 the season which consist of 14 regattas sailed up and down the gulf coast. The season will culminate in October. The team's ultimate goal is to win the overall GYA Capdevielle Championship which will be awarded January 2011 at the annual meeting. The team will be competing in its third regatta of the season when it travels to Jackson Mississippi for the Pat Gilliland Regatta April 10th and 11th.

In the mean time many of Pontchartrain's very best sailors are gearing up for a huge month of March. 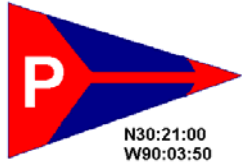

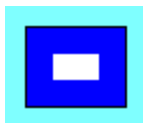

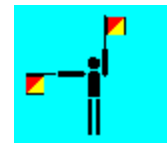
