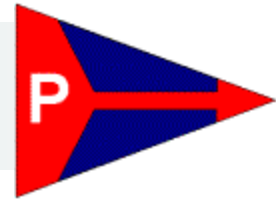

I appreciate the opportunity to serve on the PYC board. The task ahead will be both challenging and rewarding.

Tom Jarvis accomplished numerous major projects on a very limited budget. I for one commend him on his dedication to the PYC.

He also identified numerous other projects that will be necessary to maintain and improve the overall sustainability of the PYC.

As you are probably all aware, the PYC Board along with the general membership approved a special assessment to generate funds for the maintenance and improvement of the PYC.

The special assessment would generate approximately \$54,000 and according to previous estimates for maintenance and improvements the estimated cost would be about \$83,000.

We will still have a difference of approximately (\$29,000); hopefully some of the tasks can be accomplished by the assistance of the PYC members.

My first task will be, with the input from the board and members, to identify and prioritize those projects that are needed to maintain the integrity and improve the quality of the PYC.

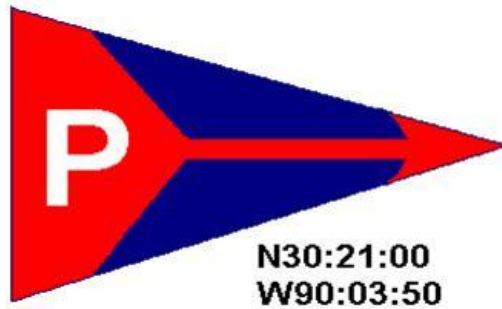

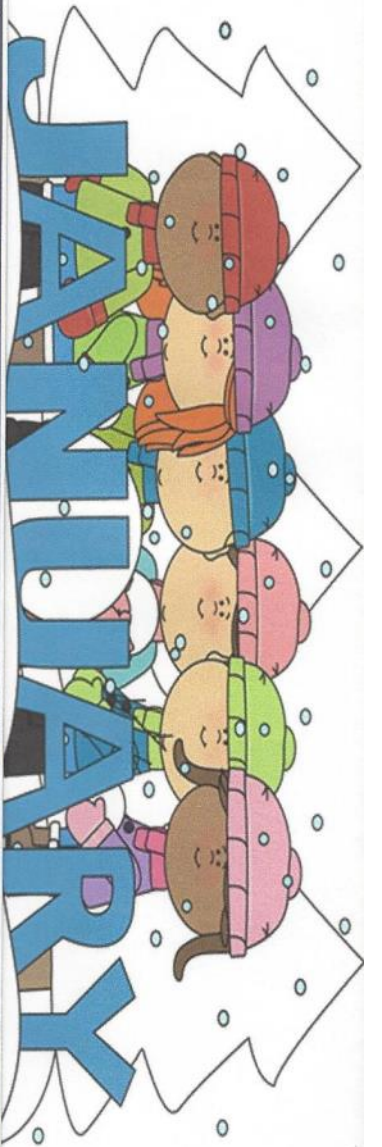
